



Our Cosmetic Consultations

At Central Dentists Tingalpa, our Cosmetic Dentists can provide you with options to help improve your smile. Our Consultations are designed to open the communication lines between yourself and your dentist in order for us to best understand your issues and concerns before we even formulate a dental treatment plan.

During this appointment, your dentist will take x-rays either in the form of a full-mouth panoramic wide view xray and where appropriate will also take a 3-D Digital Scan of your mouth. 3-D Scans are a means of collecting highly accurate pieces of information about your mouth and jaw. It helps us, to formulate equally highly accurate treatment plans for you.

All this cannot be done correctly in a 10-minute appointment. We like to be thorough, and thus our Cosmetic Consultations are fulllength.



In this appointment, we will discuss your dental history and evaluate concerns and priorities depending on budgets, comfort levels and cosmetic requirements etc.

For example, if orthodontic work is a priority and teeth straightening is required we will discuss the advantages and disadvantages between different straightening options. i.e. Choosing between Invisible Braces such as Invisalign or fixed braces like FastBraces. Another example would be in the case of dental veneers choosing between porcelain veneers or composite veneers.



The triangular-shaped brackets, along with a super-elastic wire, create the ideal combination of gentle forces to move the teeth in a more natural way. Patients will typically start seeing results within the first few weeks and will truly experience the Fastbraces® Difference.

How Fastbraces® work:

- 1. When teeth come in crooked, this means the root is typically not in the correct position
- 2. When Fastbraces® triangular braces are applied with a wire instead of square braces, the distance between the braces is almost doubled
- 3. This extra space increases the flexibility of the wire, allowing the root to be straightened upright in a year to as little as three months. Some patients see results in just a few weeks!

While a patient might shy away from orthodontic care with fixed braces, he or she may welcome treatment with Invisalign because of the many benefits it has to offer.



Veneers

Porcelain veneers are very thin pieces of custom-made ceramic porcelain that is bonded over the front surfaces of your teeth. These veneers are placed at the front of the tooth to provide a safe and effective transformation method. Porcelain veneers can change your tooth's shape, colour, and size to improve your smile's overall look.

Porcelain veneers can be used to hide gaps, imperfections, and acute discoloration in your teeth. Our dentists can solve these irregularities by using our strong and long-lasting veneers to achieve a beautiful new smile immediately in just a few appointments. You will not find a better alternative that offers a long-lasting smile in fewer visits to the dentist.

High-quality porcelain veneers are stain-resistant, making our veneers an extremely popular dental option for patients seeking a brilliant, healthy-looking smile that will last. Porcelain Veneers are more expensive than composite veneers. Talk to your dentist, who will let you know whether a composite or porcelain veneer is suited for your situation.

Porcelain veneers are known for their durability and resistance to stains, as they can last 10-15 years with proper care and regular dental check-ups.

Composite Veneers can also change the shape, size and colour of your smile. One advantage is, it can be done in just one visit. Treatment with composite veneers involves the gradual layering and bonding of high-quality resin material to the teeth. Composite veneers are used successfully to cover-up misshapen teeth, discolouration and defects.

The disadvantage to using composite veneers, the material is weaker than porcelain, and it will need to be replaced more frequently than porcelain.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR IN A WELL-MADE VENEER

Without a doubt, creating veneers for our patients is a craft. Well-made porcelain veneers are never one shade of colour. They will be layered with several shades of colour to mimic the way natural teeth should look and will feature areas of translucency and opacity. We also ensure our porcelain and composite veneers feel like natural teeth. How we bond the veneer to your tooth is imporant in order for you to enjoy the longest life possible.

Dental Crowns

During our Comprehensive Consultation, we will be able to determine what is the right type of crown for your tooth. The right crown will ensure long-term life of your crown, will feel natural, and will blend in seamlessly with your existing adjacent teeth.

Once upon a time, extracting your broken or decayed tooth may have been the only viable solution. But today, using the right dental techniques and materials we can save them.

This is where Dr. Paul Sideris and his experienced team can help you.

Dental Crowns are generally placed when there is 40% of your tooth remaining visible above the gumline. A crown would not be placed for purely aesthetic reasons if your tooth is in good condition. We would use Veneers for a healthy tooth, which needs aesthetic improvement.

Tooth-coloured composite resin fillings are a great choice when there is more than 60% of your tooth remaining.

An onlay is a conservatively prepared crown, prepared in a similar fashion to regular crowns. They are produced in a dental laboratory.

The type of crowns we produce here are:

- All Ceramic Crowns (Either Emax, or Zirconia),
- Gold Crowns and
- Porcelain Fused to Gold Crowns (PFM's).

During our Comprehensive Consultations, we will take a 3D-Scan of your smile, an impression of your teeth and surrounding area and also discuss your dental history and your needs. All this helps us to design your crown for the longest life possible.

A crown placed very quickly without planning and without taking into account various factors may not give the best long-lasting results.

General Dentistry

At The Dentist, we have an endless number of options to improve anything about your teeth that makes you shy or self-conscious. Some of the options may be minimally invasive and easily affordable; others may need careful planning and a significant investment of time and finances. WHITE FILLINGS

If your teeth have reached that time when repairs are necessary, you're in need of some restorations or fillings. When a filling is required there are a variety of materials that can be used composite resin is the most common, but depending on the requirements of the tooth and the way your teeth bite together, other materials may be recommended such as: Glass Ionomers, Cement, Porcelain and Crowns.

White fillings also help protect your teeth from being further damaged by decay, by stopping more bacteria getting in. Colour-matched to your natural teeth, white fillings are hardly noticeable.

Our Work

When you attend your appointment for a white filling, you will notice our dentists taking the time and care to prepare your tooth appropriately prior to placing the filling material as well we take no shortcuts. All bonding steps appropriate to the material we use are followed.


